

And many more. These compounds can be found in floor and carpet cleaners, degreasers, toilet/tub/tile cleaners, room deodorizers, oven cleaners, furniture polishes and waxes, laundry detergents and disinfectants.

According to a 20 year study that has now been published in various medical journals, evidence showed that everyday household cleaners you pick up at the store can have the same impact as smoking a pack of cigarettes every day.

In the study, women who used typical cleaning products regularly for 20 years had a significantly faster decline in lung function compared to women who did not use cleaning products.

The good news is that safer cleaning products are available. To start, be sure to read all labels well. Do not assume a green bottle labeled "natural" is toxin-free. Also consider the following pointers to avoid purchasing toxic cleaners:



Consider products with:

- Citrus or plant-based oils: orange and lemon for degreasing, tea tree and eucalyptus for disinfecting and olive for polishing
- Enzymes to break up drain clogs
- Make your own cleaning products from non-toxic ingredients such as baking soda, club soda and white vinegar.
- Focus on cleaning; disinfect only when necessary. Good cleaning habits will mean you won't need to disinfect nearly as often.
- Do not use chemical carpet cleaners.
- Avoid chlorine bleach. Consider using non-chlorine bleaches.
 Be wary of cleaners that advertise safet
- Be wary of cleaners that advertise safety only when used under certain conditions.
- Avoid cleaners carrying a "danger" or "warning" label.

For us, choosing the proper cleaning line not only made sense for health purposes, but economical as well. Some green products are super expensive, but not all of them. Shop Smart and ditch the big box stores. You have better options!







COCONUT EASTER BUNNY CAKE

hile a young girl in my hometown, a small farming community in northern Illinois, I recall the beginning of my culinary skills taking form. Aside from my mother sharing her many savory recipes for me to try, as a Girl Scout I was able to put my talents and ambitions to the test. Chef Diana was on her way to creating the greatest cookbook for her Mum, bounded by shiny, gold fasteners and laminated with clear contact paper.

All kidding aside, one of my fondest memories of baking during the Easter season with the Girl Scouts, was making an Easter bunny cake. So without further adieu, I present the Coconut Easter Bunny Cake recipe.

INGREDIENTS:

- 3 sticks of butter, softened
- 2 1/2 cups sugar
- 6 extra-large eggs, at room temperature
- 1 1/2 teaspoons vanilla
- 3 cups all-purpose flour
- 1 teaspoon baking powder
- 1 teaspoon baking soda
- 1/2 teaspoon kosher salt

- 1 cup mi
- 4 ounces sweetened shredded coconut
- Parchment Paper
- 8-inch Cake Pan
- Cream Cheese Icing
- Shredded Coconut

Let's begin:

- Preheat oven to 350 degrees.
- In a mixer fitted with the paddle attachment, cream together butter and sugar. Add eggs and vanilla.
- In a separate bowl mix together flour, baking powder, soda, salt and coconut. Add it to the butter mixture a little at a time alternating with the milk. End with adding flour coconut mixture. Do not over mix.
- Bake the cake for 30 minutes. Once cake has cooled, cut in half and cover the top of one half with frosting. Place 2nd half on top and flip both up with cut halves facing down.
- Cut a notch out of the top to form the head. Use part of the scrap to create a little tail.



- Cover the bunny in icing. You may need to put it in the refrigerator then add a second coat if you like a lot of icing like me.
- Cover the outside with shredded coconut.
- Cut and place construction paper ears in the notch on top and use jellybeans and/ or gumdrops to make the eyes and nose. If desired, tint remaining coconut green with food color, to surround the bunny.




